

U.S. Energy Prices Up 75% – 155% in Last Year


Global Energy Prices Up 120% – 550% Year Over Year

Recent Increases in Key Metal Prices, Indexed to Jan. 1, 2021






U.S. Agricultural Prices Up 20%-140% in Last Year

Florida Municipal Solar Project Phase III Update High Level of Interest from Developers

- Received proposals from seven developers for 28 sites
 - Three potential short-listed proposers, ~18 sites
 - Diverse geographical locations statewide; optimize solar exposure
- Potentially two to five 75 MW sites (up to ~375 MW)
 - Commercial operation no later than Dec. 31, 2026
- Power Purchase Agreement (PPA)
 - 20-year, \$/MWh pricing
 - Cost ceiling <~\$34/MWh (solar only; levelized over 20 years)
- Options for co-located battery storage, including potential future installation
- Duke and FPL Interconnection
