

Gas Storage at 5 Year Highs as Warm Start to Winter


Storage Inventory for Ending December 28



Natural Gas Supply Continued Expansion


Power/LNG Demand Offsetting Supply Growth as of January 5th

Last 45 Days Supply / Demand Detail (Bcf/day)




Gas \$1.19/MMBtu Below Budget, Warm Winter Start


Forward Natural Gas Curve as of January 5th

Current Cold Only Partially Offsetting Warm Winter Start





Limitations For Unbundled Cost Estimation for Peer Systems


