FMPA RFP 2024-116
Questions & Answers – Revision 2/20/24**

1Q: I took a quick peak at the Bid and did not see any power generation/distribution or HVAC equipment listed i.e. generators, transformers, distribution panels, dehumidifiers, packaged AC, chillers, etc. I understand they are not as utilized as the heavy equipment or general equipment needs, but I am curious how those rentals and services will be vetted or qualified after this bid is awarded?

1A: This RFP lists the items that the facilities see a need for in the near future. The quotes placed on the bid form will also help us to complete the evaluation. If a bidder provides other rental or leasing equipment, they are still able to submit a response with those items. Please see the Proposal Contents section that states “provide a copy of your catalog” or provide a list of items with their costs. Note, if a bidder provides a catalog or pricing on equipment that is not like what is listed in the RFP, it is then up to the Review Team’s discretion to determine whether there is need or desire to award to that bidder for those types of items. From the procurement side, we would like to see the bid forms filled out to the best of your ability; not completing the bidforms (*pricing sheets*) is problematic during the evaluation process.

2Q: Is FMPA willing to accept a insurance certificate that names you as certificate holder but not additional insured? Is FMPA willing to drop the hold harmless clause were you or your members are in total control of the equipment and its operation?

2A: If there are exceptions to our terms or the agreement, please note the exceptions on the AOC -1 page. We will take it to legal for review at that time.

3Q: Is this bid for rental/lease services with Operator or without?

3A: Both; without operator for most. The cranes are with and without operator. See the bidform.

4Q: if the bid is for rental//lease with Operator, can we bid for rental of equipment only without operator services?

4A: yes

5Q: Rental Pricing form on page 36: What is the Unit measure for Rental Price ?

5A: Daily. However, we expect that bidders will also provide weekly or 4-week pricing if applicable, on a separate sheet of paper.

6Q: please confirm if Liquidated damages provisions on page 28 mostly apply to timely replacement or fix of equipment in this bid?

6A: yes

7Q: Rental Pricing (Blue Skies) – could you clarify what Blue Skies mean?

7A: pricing and use unrelated to storms, if applicable.
