1Q: I don't see any quantities on this, can you let me know what they are asking for? Maybe a price sheet or something like that?

1A: To clarify, this is not one project. This award will be used as labor support, as needed, for different projects that require the skills and trades listed in the scope and bidform on page BF-2. Please note, per the bidform, that we are requesting your hourly rates per skill/trade, travel rates, per diem, and mark up costs. If you use rental equipment and pass along the cost to the end user, please provide a list of rental equipment with the cost and your markup.

2Q: Thanks for this opportunity. I was curious as to what kind of volume your Electrical Contractors see from all FMPA facilities. I know you are spread out through the state. Is this a limited work load for emergency services, along with projects that arise?

2A: To clarify, this is not one project. This contract will be used as labor support as needed for different projects that require these trades. As such, we do not have an anticipated number of hours. In the past year, the manhours have 2,000 - 2,500. In short, it could be less or more hours combined for miscellaneous projects throughout the year.

3Q: I'm not sure this RFP applies to our relationship with FMPA. The field services that we provide are only scoped in regards to removing or installing specific equipment. This RFP tends to be much broader and unspecified general plant maintenance. We can provide some of these other trades, but would only do the work if involving our related service.

3A: Yes, any field rates related to your area, skills, or trade are appreciated.
